

Section _____ Advertising Of Motor Vehicles Over The Internet and Jurisdiction of [State or Provincial] Courts. Any person who is not doing business as a motor vehicle dealer in this [state or province] for purposes of [cite to relevant motor dealer licensing statute] so as to be required to obtain a dealer's license, but who displays or causes to be displayed on the Internet any advertisement or offer for the sale of motor vehicles, shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of this [state or province] for action, suit or proceeding relating to the advertisement or offer and brought by the person who viewed the advertisement or offer in this state if: The advertisement or offer is viewed or accessed by a person in this [state or province], and

The person contacts the advertiser or offeror through electronic or other means, and
The person and advertiser or offeror enter into an agreement for the sale or transfer of a motor vehicle or the person transmits funds to the advertiser or offeror through any means including but not limited to credit card, debit card, electronic funds transfer, or check.

Any person displaying or causing to be displayed such advertisement under the circumstances set forth herein shall be deemed to have appointed the Secretary of State as the agent of such person upon whom may be served all lawful process in any action, suit, or proceeding against such person relating to the advertisement or offer, and the person shall be deemed to have agreed that any process against him or her which is so served shall be of the same legal force and validity as if served personally on the person. Service of process shall be in accordance with and in the same manner as now provided for service of process upon nonresidents under the provisions of [cite statute or rule].
